



Locally we have sung throughout the state, including an overflow audience at the Circular Congregation Church in Charleston as part of the 2015 Piccolo Spoleto festival. Under the direction of Dr. Lillian Quackenbush, 2018 marks the 36th season of "South Carolina's Musical Ambassadors."
